EXTRACT FROM THE RULES:

4. The objects of the Society shall be:

- 4.1 To foster the making of models, both working and scenic.
- 4.2 To encourage the acquisition of skills, arts, and handicrafts, and to arrange lectures and instruction aimed at furthering these crafts.
- 4.3 The acquisition and provision of a centre of model engineering
- 4.4 To arrange for the exhibition of models
- 4.5 To aid and encourage youth in acquiring knowledge and skill in mechanical and technical pursuits.
- 4.6 To provide, maintain and operate as The Society sees fit in its sole discretion, a multi-gauge miniature railway and a model boat pond for the enjoyment of members; and also for the general public when considered by The Society to be practicable.

5. MEMBERSHIP: Any person may join who has been duly proposed & seconded & has filled in the application form provided & lodged it with the secretary. The committee shall have the power to reject any application pursuant to approval by a general meeting.

6. CLASSES OF MEMBERSHIP ARE: Ordinary, Junior, Senior, Honorary, Life, Country and Affiliate members.

A Junior member is any member under 18 years.

A Senior member is a member aged 65 or more.

An Honorary member is any person who maybe accorded membership at the discretion of a general meeting.

An Honorary member shall have no vote.

A Life member shall be any member who has rendered exceptional service to the Society. Notice of notion is required for the election of life members.

A Country member is one who lives outside a radius of 40 kilometres from the club house.

7. CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP: Membership shall cease by any of the following:

- (a) Written resignation forwarded to the secretary.
- (b) By expulsion due to behaviour which discredits the Society in the eyes of the public, or who causes excessive dissension amongst the members.
- (c) By allowing his subscription to be more than 60 days in arrears, except in the case of Life members whose subscription is automatically waived.

When ever possible members are expected to assist with Club Projects.
